Notes

Enfold Us was commissioned by Alexander Einarsson and the Petri Sångare in celebration of the ensemble's 10th anniversary season. Because of the COVID-19 pandemic the premiere was presented 'virtually' on October 3, 2020.

The text is by composer Leslie Bassett, with whom I studied at the University of Michigan. I admired Leslie. He was like a second father to me and he helped me imagine and navigate much of my professional and artistic life. Even these words provided guidance and after several rough-and-tumble years reawakened something in me that had been dormant for too long. Leslie grew up around animals and I recall him saying that he was allergic to their dander. Still, I can't help picturing the Holy Spirit leaning against us the way horses sometimes do. Powerful, yet gentle (and perceptive) creatures.

In the midst of the global pandemic, when all of humanity is subject to forces beyond our collective control, Leslie's prayer makes clear that we are surrounded by something even more powerful, more universal, more enduring.

Performance Notes

Enfold Us should be performed with a sense of expansiveness and rubato, with rich, full sonorities, especially on words like 'cosmos,' 'enfold' and 'lean.' The middle section can be taken a bit faster, but together with the shift in tonality even a slight change in intensity or tone might be sufficient in and of itself. The parenthetical *fermati* are intended to provide freedom and flexibility, but should not disrupt the overall sense of phrase.

Pulsations of notes within individual sonorities (e.g., measures 7, 10, 24-25, etc.) should be audible and emphasized. Enunciation of the sibilant 'S' should always be minimized.




